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In a session with 18 female and male in-care youth, the participants expressed that they:



Do not feel stable

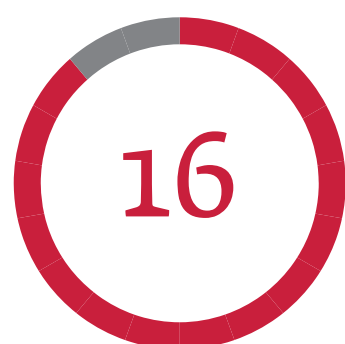
Would not know how to deal with legal problems which may arise after they leave care

Do not have a clear picture about where and with whom they will live after they leave care

Are worried about the future

Do not know about the services that are offered by the Ministry of Social Development and are available to them after leaving care

Are not proud of themselves

Feel like they will be discriminated against after leaving care

Regulation No. 49 of 2009 on the Licensing and Management of Children's Homes:

Homes must create an environment that is conducive to the development of children and provide a secure family setting where children can enjoy excellent physical and mental health and thus develop the social, emotional and other capacities that they need to learn. These arrangements are used when there is no possibility of housing a child with a family member or a suitable alternative family.
